Isa 62:2 The Gentiles shall see your righteousness, And all kings your glory. <mark>You</mark> shall be called by a new name, Which the mouth of the LORD will name.

Rev 4:3 And He who sat there was like a jasper² and a sardius stone in appearance; and *there was* <u>a rainbow around the throne</u>, in appearance like an emerald.

Rev 4:4 Around the throne were <u>twenty-four</u> <u>thrones</u>, and on the thrones I saw twenty-four <u>elders sitting</u>, clothed in white robes; and they had crowns of gold on their heads.

Rev 4:5 And from the throne proceeded lightnings, thunderings, and voices. Seven lamps of fire *were* burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

Rev 4:6 Before the throne *there was* a <u>sea of</u> — <u>glass, like crystal</u>. And in the midst of the throne, and around the throne, *were* <u>four living creatures</u>—full of eyes in front and in back.

Rev 4:7 The first living creature *was* like a <u>lion</u>, the second living creature like a <u>calf</u>, the third living creature had a face like a <u>man</u>, and the fourth living creature *was* like a flying <u>eagle</u>. Rev 4:8 The four living creatures, each having <u>six</u> <u>wings, were full of eyes around and within</u>. And they do not rest day or night, saying: "<u>Holy, holy, -</u> <u>holy, Lord God Almighty</u>, Who was and is and is

to come!"

Rev 4:9 Whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who lives forever and ever,

Rev 4:10 the twenty-four elders fall down before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him who lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying:

Rev 4:11 "You are worthy, O Lord, To receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, And by Your will they exist and were created."

Ezekiel 1:1 ...that the heavens were ▶ opened and I saw visions^[a] of God. **Eze 8:1** ... as I <u>sat</u> in my house <u>with the elders</u> of Judah sitting before me, <u>that</u> the hand of the Lord GOD fell upon me there...**Eze 8:3** He stretched out the form of a hand, and took me by a lock of my hair; and the **Spirit lifted me up between earth and heaven**, and brought me in visions of God to <u>Jerusalem</u>, to the door of the north gate of the inner *court*, <u>where the seat of the image</u> <u>of jealousy</u> was, which provokes to jealousy.

Eze 1:26 And above the firmament over their heads *was* the **likeness of a throne**, in appearance like a <u>sapphire stone</u>; on the likeness of the throne *was* a likeness with the appearance of a man high above it. Eze 1:27 Also from the appearance of His waist and upward I saw, as it were, the color of amber with the appearance of fire all around within it; and from the appearance of His waist and downward I saw, as it were, the appearance of fire with brightness all around. Eze 1:28 Like the appearance of a man high above it. This *was* the appearance of the likeness of the brightness all around it. This *was* the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD. So when I saw *it*, I fell on my face, and I heard a voice of One speaking.

Dan 7:9 "**I watched till thrones were put in place**, And the Ancient of Days was seated; ...**The court was seated**, And the books were opened.

Isa 24:23 ... For the LORD of hosts will reign On Mount Zion and in Jerusalem And before His elders, gloriously.

Ezek 1:22 ...The likeness of the <u>firmament</u> (space) above the heads of the living creatures^[a]was like the color of an <u>awesome **crystal**</u>

Eze 1:5 Also from within it *came* the likeness of four living creatures. ... Eze 1:6 Each one had four faces, and each one had *four wings*. ... They sparkled like the color of burnished bronze...Eze 1:10 As for the likeness of their faces, *each* had the **face** of a <u>man..lion .. ox... and eagle</u>. (Same as Ezekiel Ch. 10)

Eze 10:12 And their whole body, with their back, their hands, their wings, and the wheels that the four had were full of eyes all around.



Isa 6:2 Above it stood seraphim; each one had **six wings**: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. Isa 6:3 And one cried to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; The whole earth is full of His glory!"



Rev 5:1 And I saw in the right *hand* of Him who sat on the throne **a scroll written inside and on the back**, sealed with seven seals.

Rev 5:2 Then I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, "Who is worthy to open the scroll and to loose its seals?"

 \dot{Rev} 5:3 And no one in heaven or on the earth or under the earth was able to open the scroll, or to look at it.

Rev 5:4 So I wept much, because no one was found worthy to open and read the scroll, or to look at it.

Rev 5:5 But one of the elders said to me, "Do not weep. Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has prevailed to open the scroll and to loose its seven seals."

Rev 5:6 And I looked, and behold, in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, **stood a Lamb as though it had been slain**, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent out into all the earth.

Rev 5:7 Then He came and took the scroll out of the right hand of Him / who sat on the throne.

Rev 5:8 Now when He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the **saints**.

Rev 5:9 And they sang a new song, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, And to open its seals; For You were slain, And have redeemed us to God by Your blood Out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation,

Rev 5:10 And have made us kings and priests to our God; And we shall reign on the earth."

Rev 5:11 Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne, the living creatures, and the elders; <u>and the number of them was ten</u> thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands,

Rev 5:12 saying with a loud voice: "<u>Worthy is the Lamb</u> who was slain To receive power and riches and wisdom, And strength and honor and glory and blessing!"

Rev 5:13 And every creature which is <u>in heaven and on the earth</u> and <u>under the</u> <u>earth and such as are in the sea</u>, and **all that** are in them, I heard saying: "<u>Blessing</u> <u>and honor and glory and power *Be* to Him who sits on the throne, And to the Lamb,</u> <u>forever and ever</u>!"

Rev 5:14 Then the four living creatures said, "Amen!" And the twenty-four elders fell down and worshiped Him who lives forever and ever.

Rev 6:1 Now I saw when the Lamb <u>opened one of the seals</u>; and I heard one of the four living creatures saying with a voice like thunder, "Come and see." **Rev 6:2** And I looked, and behold, **a white horse**. He who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and **he went out conquering and to conquer**. **Rev 6:3** When He opened the second seal, I heard the second living creature saying, "Come and see." (World ruler conquers world)

Rev 6:4 Another **horse**, **fiery red**, went out. And it was granted to the one who sat on it to take peace from the earth, and that <u>people should kill one another</u>; and there was given to him a great sword. (*War, conflict, death*)

Rev 6:5 When He opened the third seal, I heard the third living creature say, "Come and see." So I looked, and behold, **a black horse**, and he who sat on it had a **pair of scales in his hand.**

Rev 6:6 And I heard a voice in the midst of the four living creatures saying, "A quart of wheat for a denarius, and three quarts of barley for a denarius; and do not harm the oil and the wine." (*Famine*)

Rev 6:7 When He opened the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth living creature saying, "Come and see." Rev 6:8 So I looked, and behold, a pale horse. And the name of him who sat on it was Death, and Hades followed with him. And power was given to them over a fourth of the earth, to kill with sword, with hunger, with death, and by the beasts of the earth. (Death)

Isa 14:15 Yet you shall be brought down to Sheol, To the lowest depths of the Pit (future).

Isa 14:9 "Hell from beneath is excited... to meet

you at your coming; It stirs up the dead for you, All the chief ones of the earth; It has raised up from their thrones All the kings of the nations.

Isa 49:13 Sing, O heavens! (= *Rev* 18:20)

Jer 48:28 You who dwell in Moab, <u>Leave</u> the cities and dwell in the rock, And be like the dove *which* makes her nest In the sides of the cave's mouth. (Similar to Ezekiel 7:16)

Jer 48:9 "<u>Give wings to Moab,</u> That she may flee and get away...

Rev 13:1 Then I stood on the sand of the sea. And I saw a beast rising up out of the sea, having seven heads and **ten horns**, and on his horns ten crowns, and on his heads a blasphemous name. Rev 13:2 Now the beast which I saw was like a leopard, his feet were like *the feet of* a bear, and his mouth like the mouth of a lion. The <u>dragon</u> gave him his power, his throne, and great authority.

Rev 13:3 And I saw one of his heads as if it had been mortally wounded, and his deadly wound was healed. And all the world marveled and followed the beast. Rev

13:4 So they worshiped the dragon who gave authority to the beast; and they worshiped the beast, saying, "Who *is* like the beast? Who is able to make war with him?"

Rev 13:5 And he was given a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies, and he was given authority to continue for forty-two months. (3.5 years)

Rev 13:6 Then he opened his mouth in blasphemy against God to blaspheme His name. His tabernacle, and those who dwell in heaven.

Rev 13:7 It was granted to him to make war with the saints and to overcome them.

And authority was given him over every tribe, tongue, and nation. Rev 13:8 All who dwell on the earth will worship him, whose names have not been written in the Book of Life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

Rev 13:9 If anyone has an ear, let him hear. Rev 13:10 He who leads into captivity shall go into captivity; he who kills with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the saints (*See Ch.14:12).

Rev 13:11 Then I saw another beast coming up out of the earth, and he had two horns like a lamb and spoke like a dragon. Rev 13:12 And he exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence, and **causes the earth and those who** dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed.

Rev 13:13 He performs great signs, so that he even makes fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men. **Rev 13:14** And he deceives those who dwell on the earth—by those signs which he was granted to do in the sight of the beast, telling those who dwell on the earth to <mark>make an image</mark> to the beast who was wounded by the sword and lived. Rev 13:15 He was granted *power* to give breath to the **image** of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak and cause **as many as would** not worship the image of the beast to be

killed. Rev 13:16 He causes all, both small and great, richand poor, free and slave, <mark>to receive a mark on their right</mark> hand or on their foreheads, Rev 13:17 and that no one **may buy or sell** except one who has the mark or the name of the beast, or the number of his name. Rev 13:18 Here is wisdom. Let him who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man: His number **2:166 i6ect** (+1) references to the OT

Rev 14:2 And I heard a voice from heaven, like the voice of many waters, and like the voice of loud thunder. And I heard the sound of harpists playing their harps.

Rev 14:3 They sang as it were <u>a new song</u> before the throne, before the four living creatures, and the elders; and no one could learn that song except the hundred *and* forty-four thousand who were <u>redeemed</u> from the earth.

Rev 14:4 These are the ones who were not defiled with women, for they are virgins. These are the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes. These were <u>redeemed</u> from *among* men, *being* **firstfruits** to God and to the Lamb.

Rev 14:5 And in their mouth was found no deceit, for they are without fault <u>before the throne of God</u>.

Rev 14:6 Then I saw another angel flying in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach to those who dwell on the earth to every nation, tribe, tongue, and people— Rev 14:7 saying with a loud voice, "Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water." Rev 14:8 And another angel followed, saying, "Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because she has made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication." Rev 14:9 Then a third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, "If anyone worships the beast and his image, and receives his mark on his forehead or on his hand, 10 he himself shall also drink of the wine of the **wrath of God**, which is poured out full strength into the cup of His indignation. He shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb. Rev 14:11 And the smoke of their torment ascends forever and ever; and they have no rest day or night, who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name." Rev 14:12 Here is the patience of the Saints (repeated 13:10); here are those who keep the commandments of God and the faith of Jesus. (Jews and Gentiles)

Rev 14:13 <u>Then</u> I heard a voice from heaven saying to me, "Write: **'Blessed** are the dead who die in the Lord from now on.' " "Yes," says the Spirit, "<u>that they may rest</u> from their labors, and their works follow them "

"Blessed are those who die" **"Here is the patience of the saints"** is said in ch.13:10 in context of the 666 Antichrist mark, and here in 14:12 after a warning about the Antichrist mark. Why? Jesus repeats it TWICE (so it must be important). Endure till then end.

<u>The Harvest o</u>f the <mark>sheep</mark> and <mark>goats</mark>,

Rev 14:14 <u>Then</u> I looked, and behold, <u>a white cloud</u>, and on the cloud sat *One* like the <u>Son of Man</u>, having on His head a golden crown, and in His hand a <u>sharp sickle</u>.

Rev 14:15 And another angel came <u>out of the temple</u>, crying with a loud voice to Him who sat on the cloud, "Thrust in Your sickle and reap, for the <u>time has come for You to reap</u>, for the <u>harvest of the earth is ripe</u>."

Rev 14:16 So He who sat on the cloud thrust in His sickle on the earth, and the earth was reaped.

Rev 14:17 Then another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle.

Rev 14:18 And another angel came out from the altar, who had power over fire, and he cried with a loud cry to him who had the sharp sickle, saying, "Thrust in your sharp sickle and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth, for her grapes are fully ripe."

Rev 14:19 So the angel thrust his sickle into the earth and gathered the vine of the earth, and threw *it* into the great winepress of the wrath of God.

Rev 14:20 And the winepress was trampled outside the city, and <u>blood</u> came out of the winepress, up to the horses' bridles, for one thousand six hundred furlongs.

Rev 15:1 Then I saw <u>another sign</u> in heaven, great and marvelous: seven angels having the <u>seven last plagues</u>, for in them the wrath of God is complete. Rev 15:2 And I saw *something* like a sea of glass mingled with fire, and those who have the <u>victory over</u> the beast, over his image and over his mark and over the number of his name, standing on the sea of glass, having harps of God.

Rev 15:3 They <u>sing</u> the song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying: "<u>Great and marvelous *are* Your works</u>, Lord God Almighty! Just and true *are* Your ways, O King of the saints!

Rev 15:4 Who shall not fear You, O Lord, and glorify Your name? For *You* alone *are* holy. For all nations shall come and worship before You, For Your judgments have been manifested."

Rev 15:5 After these things I looked, and behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened. =ch.11

Rev 15:6 And **out of the temple** came the <u>seven angels</u> having the <u>seven</u> <u>plagues</u>, clothed in pure bright linen, and having their chests girded with golden bands.

Rev 15:7 Then one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls <u>full of the wrath of God</u> who lives forever and ever. Rev 15:8 The temple was <u>filled with smoke from the glory of God and</u> from His power, and no one was able to enter the temple <u>till the seven</u> <u>plagues</u> of the seven angels were <u>completed</u>. the <mark>wheat</mark>, and <mark>tares</mark>.

Joel 3:13 Put in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe. Come, go down; For the winepress is full, The vats overflow— For their wickedness is great."

Jer 51:33 For thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: "The daughter of Babylon *is* like a threshing floor *When* it is time to thresh her; **Yet a little while and the time of her harvest will come**."

Rev 16:1 Then I heard a loud voice from the temple saying to the seven angels, "Go and pour out the bowls of the <u>wrath of God</u> on the earth."

Rev 16:2 So the first went and poured out his bowl upon the earth, and <u>a foul and</u> loathsome sore came upon the men who had the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image.

Rev 16:3 Then the second angel poured out his bowl on the sea, and it became blood as of a dead man; and every living creature in the sea died.

Rev 16:4 Then the third angel poured out his bowl on the <u>rivers and springs of</u> water, and they became blood.

Rev 16:5 And I heard the angel of the waters saying: "You are righteous, O Lord, The One who is and who was and who is to be, Because You have judged these things. Rev 16:6 For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, And You have given them blood to drink ⁽²⁾. For it is their just due."

Rev 16:7 And I heard another from the altar saying, "Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous *are* Your judgments."

Rev 16:8 Then the fourth angel poured out his bowl on the sun, and power was

given to him to scorch men with fire.

Rev 16:9 And men were scorched with great heat, and they blasphemed the name of God who has power over these plagues; and they did not repent and give Him glory. Rev 16:10 Then the fifth angel poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and <u>his kingdom became full of darkness</u>; and they gnawed their tongues because of the pain. (*underground base?*)

Rev 16:11 They blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and did not repent of their deeds.

Rev 16:12 Then the sixth angel poured out his bowl on the great river Euphrates, and its water was dried up, so that the way of the kings from the east might be prepared. Rev 16:13 And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs *coming* out of the mouth of the dragon, out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet. Rev 16:14 For they are spirits of demons, performing signs, *which* go / out to the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.

*Rev 16:15 "Behold, <u>I am coming as a thief</u>. <u>Blessed is he who watches</u>, and keeps his garments, lest he walk naked and they see his shame."

Rev 16:16 And they gathered them together to the
